I requested an increase to the US Army Corps of Engineers Central New Mexico Program (Section 593) to be included in the Water Resources Development Act of 2022. This program provides design and construction assistance to non-Federal partners in the counties of Bernalillo, Sandoval, and Valencia in the state of New Mexico. The purpose of this program is to support the development of publicly owned water-related environmental infrastructure and resource protection projects. The program includes projects for wastewater treatment and related facilities, water supply, conservation and related facilities, storm water retention and remediation, environmental restoration, and surface water resources protection and development.
